A recipient of the 2009 John Simon Guggenheim Foundation Fellowship, Dr. Oscar Zanetti (La Habana, Cuba 1946) graduated with a degree in History from Universidad de La Habana, where he was Professor and Chair of the History Department. He has been a member of the Academia de Ciencias de Cuba and has taught graduate and post-graduate courses at various universities, including Universidad Autónoma de Santo Domingo, State University of Moscow, Universidad Autónoma de Nicaragua, Universidad Veracruzana, Universidad Autónoma de Barcelona, Universidad de San Martín (Argentina) y Universidad Autónoma de México. Dr. Zanetti was Research Director of the Instituto de Historia de Cuba and currently presides over the Historical Literature Section of the Unión de Escritores y Artistas de Cuba. He is also currently Scholar in Residence at American University, Washington, DC.

Zanetti's publications include *Comercio y poder: Relaciones cubano-hispano-norteamericanas en torno a 1898* (Casa de Las Américas, 1998); *Las manos en el dulce* (La Habana, Editorial de Ciencias Sociales, 2004); *Isla en la Historia: La historiografía de Cuba en el siglo XX* (La Habana, Ediciones Unión, 2005); *La República: Notas sobre economía y sociedad* (La Habana, Editorial de Ciencias Sociales, 2006), and *Economía azucarera cubana: Estudios históricos* (La Habana, Ciencias Sociales, 2009), among others.
