Victor Bulmer-Thomas is a visiting professor at Florida International University and Professor Emeritus at London University. He is also an Associate Fellow of Chatham House, where he was Director from 2001-2006 and Senior Distinguished Fellow of the School of Advanced Study at University of London. From 1992-1998 he was the director of the University's Institute of Latin American Studies and Editor of the Journal of Latin American Studies from 1986-1997. The author or editor of 20 books on Latin America, he is currently researching an economic history of the Caribbean since the Napoleonic Wars.
