**Journal/Final Paper** (Journal entries + 4 pages). This course deliverable is designed to offer students with the opportunity to share ongoing research and reflections related to the Haitian Creole Language and Haitian Culture. Each student will submit two journals each week. Journal entries will be ½ page. The final paper provides an opportunity for students to reflect upon their journal entries and present a comprehensive work informed by their experience, research, coursework. The final paper must be done in Haitian Creole. All papers are due by 11:30 pm on July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

**Final Oral Exam.** Will assess each individual student’s language ability and measure their improvement over the course of the program. Final oral assessment will be conducted on Friday July 29, 2022.

**Incompletes.** Incompletes will be given only in case of major illness or Acts of God.
