The LACC Impact Publication Program (LACC-IPUB)

Fostering FIU's Academic Research on Latin America and the Caribbean

Recognizing the importance of disseminating FIU research conducted on Latin America and the Caribbean, LACC is proud to launch a new initiative to increase exposure of faculty publications in highly reputed academic journals. Through the LACC Impact Publication Program (LACC-IPUB), the Center seeks to support Open Access publications in scientific and educational outlets in any discipline.

LACC-IPUB aims to enhance the diffusion of FIU-produced research and knowledge in the region. It will facilitate access of LACC Affiliated Faculty publications to different communities worldwide, especially in Latin America and the Caribbean. LACC-IPUB will match article-processing charges (APCs) up to \$1,000 per publication to secure the article's open access publication.

Eligibility: The LACC-IPUB is accessible to any LACC Affiliated Faculty member. One of the article's authors must hold an appointment in an FIU department, Center, or institute at the time of publication. The article must reflect research or inquiry on Latin America or the Caribbean. It must be accepted for publication in a leading journal or the top 10% of journals ranked by CiteScore in any discipline.

Funding Level & Duration: LACC anticipates funding up to five articles per year with a maximum award of \$1,000 per article. LACC will match Open Access fees up to \$1,000 per article. Financial support will be given on a first-come, first-served basis.

Application and Contact: Once an article has been accepted for publication, financing requests should be sent by email to Verbolet Moise (vmoise@fiu.edu). The email should include an abstract of the article, the journal where it has been accepted, and the requested amount. The LACC directors--José Miguel Cruz, Gabriela Hoberman, and Liesl Picard--will review the requests, and the applicant will be notified within 48 hours.
