2024 Call for Applications

The Kimberly Green Latin American and Caribbean Center (LACC) is pleased to announce the extension for the 2024 call of the Tinker Foundation Field Research Collaborative grant applications.

LACC's Tinker grant program funds **graduate student** travel to any Latin American and Caribbean country (regardless of language) to conduct pre-dissertation research directly related to the region.

Travel will be subject to requirements and restrictions established by FIU.

Requirements:

- Be a graduate student in any FIU academic program.
- Be in the early stages of the graduate degree program.

The funding cycle for 2024 will cover research travel and field-related expenses for graduate students. Travel expenses include air ticket, lodging, and transportation up to \$2,500 per student.
